#### PHIL MARCUS - A TRIBUTE


We are sorry to hear the sad news that Strider Phil Marcus passed away on May 16th. Phil was a remarkable 104 years old.

### ALLEY POND STRIDERS GO TO WASHINGTON BY RANDI OPSAHL

Every spring the annual National Cherry Blossom Festival in Washington, DC commemorates the 1912 gift of cherry blossom trees from Mayor Yukio Ozaki of Tokyo to Washington, DC. The

festival includes one of the nation's premier 10-mile races, the Credit Union Cherry Blossom 10 Mile run, as well as the 5K. A group of Alley Pond Striders traveled to our nation's capital the first week of April to participate.

Several of us started our adventure on Thursday, April 3, at the fabulous Moynihan Train Station where we boarded Amtrak for a comfortable, 3.5-hour journey. After checking into our hotel we headed to Arlington National Cemetery where we watched the changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and visited the grave of President John F. Kennedy. The Marine Corps War Memorial, which is just outside the cemetery, was also on the list.

The 2.2 mile long National Mall provides options for everyone. Anchored by the Lincoln Memorial on the west and the Capitol on the east, with 11 of the Smithsonian Institution's museums along the way, you can spend a full day there and barely scratch the surface. The Vietnam Veterans Memorial and the Charters of Freedom at the National Archives were highlights. An additional out-





ing to see the memorials illuminated at night was worth the extra miles we walked.

On Friday, we worked our way to the National Buildings Museum for the race expo. Wasn't that the reason we were here? Easy to forget in a city as interesting as DC. We met up with our fellow Striders who had just arrived, picked up our numbers and started mentally preparing for the races ahead.

The 5K took place on Saturday, April 5. Helen and Joey Pasqual, Lynn Leon and Venice Naidoo ran while the rest of us cheered them on. It was the first half of the Double Blossom challenge for Lynn, who would be running both the 5K and 10 Mile runs to

earn the special Double Blossom medal.

Sunday, April 6, was the 10 Mile run. Nella Carravetta, Maria Ferraro, Fran Kraus-Schmidt, Lynn Leon, Pat Mitrofanis, Venice Naidoo, Rob Pasqual, Laughlin Whalen and I made it to the start with varying goals. While several had time goals in mind—others would be happy to finish before the sweep bus (that would be me). The weather was great, the course was flat and fast, course records were set by the elite runners and most importantly, we all had fun.

When we first entered the race lottery in December 2024, some (who me?) were half hoping we



would not be selected. "It seemed like a good idea at the time" and "Who's idea was this?" were often heard on the path as we trained through the winter. Once everyone was across the finish line, and we celebrated our

shared experience, we all quickly agreed we couldn't wait to do the whole thing again next year. I look forward to being at the start with my fellow Striders in 2026

Note: Next year's races are scheduled for April 11 & 12, 2026. The lottery for the 2026 10-mile race opens on December 1, 2025. You can find race and lottery information at cherryblossom.org.
